

## **APPLICATIONS FOR THE POSITION OF DIRECTOR OF THE INSTITUTE OF SOCIAL SCIENCES OF THE UNIVERSITY OF LISBON**

1. The Institute of Social Sciences of the University of Lisbon hereby announces the opening of the candidacy process for the post of Director.

2. The Director is elected by the School Council of the Institute of Social Sciences of the University of Lisbon for a three-year term of office, which may be renewed once, and is the Institute's governing body and external institutional representative.

3. Any researcher or professor at the Institute, as well as professors or researchers from other national or foreign university or research institutions may apply for the position.

4. The Director must:

- a) Be a personality of high academic prestige;
- b) Have experience in exercising management functions in university education or research institutions;
- c) Have demonstrated the capacity to promote humanistic and scientific values in an environment of colegiality and inclusion;
- d) Possess a strategic vision appropriate for the pursuit of ICS's mission, according to the attributions established in article 2 of its Statutes.

5. The position of Director of the Institute of Social Sciences of the University of Lisbon is not remunerated, with the exception of a remuneratory supplement, foreseen in Decree-Law 388/90, December 10th, corresponding to 28% of the monthly base remuneration corresponding to index 100 of the salary scales of the careers of university lecturers, polytechnic higher education lecturers, and scientific research career.
