Call for Master Scholarship

The Institute of Social Sciences of the University of Lisbon (ICS-ULisboa) opens a call for applications for 1 (one) Research Grant for a Master's student, within the scope of the research project "ZARQ - Construindo o Povo de Salazar: Arquitectura, nacionalismo e identidade nacional (1932-1945)", funded by the Foundation for Science and Technology (FCT) (2022.03543.PTDC), coordinated by Dr Rita Almeida de Carvalho, from the Institute of Social Sciences of the University of Lisbon, under the following conditions:

1. Scientific area: History, Art History, Digital Humanities or Anthropology.

2. Admission requirements:

2.1. Candidates must have as mandatory requirements:

- a) Enrolment in a Master's programme in History, History of Art, Digital Humanities or Anthropology;
- b) Bachelor Degree in History, History of Art or Anthropology;
- c) Proficiency in Portuguese and English.

2.2. Candidates should have as preferential requirements:

- a) Experience in research projects, favouring the contemporary period;
- b) Experience in researching written and visual documentary sources;

3. Work plan:

Under the coordination of the project PI, the grantee will fulfil the following functions:

- a) Support to project management and organisation of initiatives;
- b) Research and analysis of national and foreign press, generalist and specialised;
- c) Preparation of a presentation at a scientific meeting;

4. Applicable law and regulation:

4.1. Law no. 40/2004, of 18 August, amended by Decree-Law no. 202/2012, of 27 August, by Decree-Law no. 233/2012, of 29 October, by Law no. 12/2013, of 29 January, by Decree-Law no. 89/2013, of 9 July, and by Decree-Law no. 123/2019, of 28 August ("Estatuto do Bolseiro de Investigação");

4.2. Research Grants Regulation of the Foundation for Science and Technology, I.P. (FCT, I.P.), Regulation no. 950/2019, Diário da República, 2nd series, no. 241, of 16 December and, alternatively, Research Grants Regulation of the University of Lisbon, approved by Order no. °

6238/2020 published in Diário da República, 2nd series, no. 113, of 12 June, amended by Order no. 8061/2022, published in Diário da República, 2nd series, no. 126, of 1 July.

5. Workplace: Institute of Social Sciences of the University of Lisbon.

6. Scientific supervision: The grantee's guidance will be provided by Dr. Rita Almeida de Carvalho, the project's coordinator.

7. Duration of the scholarship: The fellowship will have a duration of 3 months.

8. Benefits:

8.1. The monthly maintenance allowance is €990.98 (nine hundred and ninety euros and ninety-eight cents), paid monthly by bank transfer.

8.2. The grant holder to be hired may exercise his/her right to social security by joining the voluntary social insurance scheme, under the terms provided for in the Research Grant Holder Statute, with ICS-ULisboa assuming the costs resulting from the contributions provided for in that Statute.

9. Selection methods and their valuation:

9.1 The applicable selection methods will be curriculum evaluation and a selection interview.

9.2 The selection interview will be held with the five candidates with the best marks in the curricular evaluation, provided they score 4.5 points or more.

9.3 The selection of the candidates will be made according to the terms of reference expressed in number 2 of this announcement:

a) Curricular assessment, in view of the objectives and specific nature of the work to be developed in the project "ZARQ - Building Salazar's People: Architecture, nationalism and national identity (1932-1945)", valued from 1 to 10 points (50%);

b) Letter of Motivation, referred to in point 13.2 (c), valued from 1 to 10 points (20%);

c) Other factors considered relevant, namely research experience, publications and participation in scientific meetings, valued from 1 to 10 points (10%);

d) Selection interview to assess professional and behavioural competences, valued from 1 to 10 points (20%).

10. Composition of the Selection Board: Dr Rita Almeida de Carvalho (President), Dr Marta Prista (1st Effective Member, who will replace the President in her absence), Dr Duncan Simpson (2nd Effective Member), Dr Annarita Gori (1st Substitute Member) and Dr Filipa Vicente (2nd Substitute Member).

11 – Form of publicity/notification of results: All candidates will be notified of the final result of the evaluation, sent to the e-mail address used to send the respective application, and/or by post, to the address indicated in the attached Personal Data Form, by means of a ranked list, in descending order of the final evaluation obtained. Candidates may exercise their right to a prior written hearing within ten working days of the notification. To this end, candidates may request that the minutes be sent by email or consult the procedural documents in person at the Office during office hours.

12. Application Deadline: The call is open from **22 October 2024 to 05 November 2024**.

13. Formalization and processing of applications:

13.1. Applications must be sent by email to recrutamentos@ics.ulisboa.pt, obligatorily indicating the reference “Research Scholarship call No. 12/2024”), otherwise it will not be considered in the call.

13.2. Applications must be accompanied, under penalty of exclusion, by the following documents, and no document that must be submitted at the time of application may be submitted after the deadline for submission:

- a) Personal data form and Declaration of Consent for Communication of Results via e-mail (see attached form);
- b) Detailed and updated Curriculum Vitae;
- c) Letter of Motivation justifying the interest in the research themes to be developed and the skills with which you think you can contribute to the project "ZARQ - Building Salazar's People: Architecture, nationalism and national identity (1932-1945)";
- d) Proof of enrolment in a Master's degree in History, Art History, Digital Humanities or Anthropology;
- e) Document(s) proving that the candidate fulfils the conditions required for the type of scholarship, namely certificate(s) of qualifications of the required academic degree(s), with final average, or proof that he/she has already applied for the respective certificate(s);
- f) If the Bachelor's degree required in this Notice as a requirement for admission was obtained abroad, you must submit one of the following documents:

- Document proving that the Portuguese Institution has granted the recognition or equivalence or registration of the academic degree; or
- Document proving that the applicant has already applied for recognition of the degree, which must be submitted by the deadline for receipt of applications, inclusive; or
- Declaration of honour by the candidate that he/she will obtain the recognition of the degree until the conclusion of the contract;

- g) The presentation of proof of obtaining the recognition or equivalence or registration of the academic degree is a mandatory condition for signing the contract;
- h) For academic degrees obtained in foreign countries, which have not yet obtained either recognition or equivalence or registration of the degree, it is necessary to recognise it, under the terms provided for in Decree-Law no. 66/2018, of 16 August, in conjunction with Ordinance no. 33/2019, of 25 January.
